- ▶ Children in kindergarten through 5th grade may participate in a **Children's Sermon** about 10 minutes into the service and then 1st through 5th graders remain in the service while kindergarteners return to extended care.

Deadline: July 30

The Tampa Bay Baptist Association is collecting school supplies for the migrant and Haitian children in Hillsborough County. Donation barrels will be located in the Dining Room. Items needed include backpacks, #2 pencils, crayons, blunt scissors, black composition notebooks, spiral notebooks, rulers, pens, pocket folders, loose leaf paper, markers or highlighters, colored pencils, glue sticks, and 1" plastic 3-ring binders. The supplies are needed by July 30.
