▶ **Childcare** is provided for children through kindergarten. You will receive a pager to notify you if you are needed. Childcare is optional and you are more than welcome to keep your child with you, but please be considerate of others around you. The foyer is available to you should you need to step out.

▶ Children in kindergarten through 5th grade may participate in a **Children's Sermon** about 10 minutes into the service and then 1st through 5th graders remain in the service while kindergarteners return to extended care.
